 Erection of UPVC conservatory to rear of property

20/00988/TCA Hathaway Cottage 18 Chapel Lane Wymondham

All round and targeted reduction to restrain spread of current canopy, reduce deep shading over borders and mitigate against future, characteristic failure of long limbs (see fig.2)

- . Reduce south east spread of canopy up to 2m to give 1.5m clearance from hedge and target prune extended limb to reduce shading of lower canopy, leverage and potential for failure. (See fig 3.)

- . Reduce spread of lowest northern and southern limbs by 2m.

- . Reduce remaining upper crown by up to 1m to balance canopy.

T2: Quercus robur

Fell juvenile, self-set English oak to increase available light to border plants and

reduce potential for damaging future competition with surrounding birch group and established mulberry (see fig.4). Remove stump or treat with appropriate herbicide.
G1: Mixed group to north of drive: Rhus, Ilex & Syringa
Crown lift mixed holly and lilac in group to 3m to provide vehicular access to drive.
Reduce southern spread of both above 3m by up to 2m (see fig 6). Reduce southern spread of sumac by 2m and cut to give 0.5m clearance from building

20/01030/TCA 5 Old Manor Gardens Wymondham

T1 Birch to be reduced by no more than 2 metres all round
T2 Birch to be reduced by no more than 4 metres in height removed, with the sides matched in

20/01031/TCA The Old Police Station 17 Main Street Wymondham

T1 Sycamore - Pollard between 6 metres and 7 metres due to light issues and to keep the tree well managed.
