217 To receive declarations of interest and consider any requests for dispensations

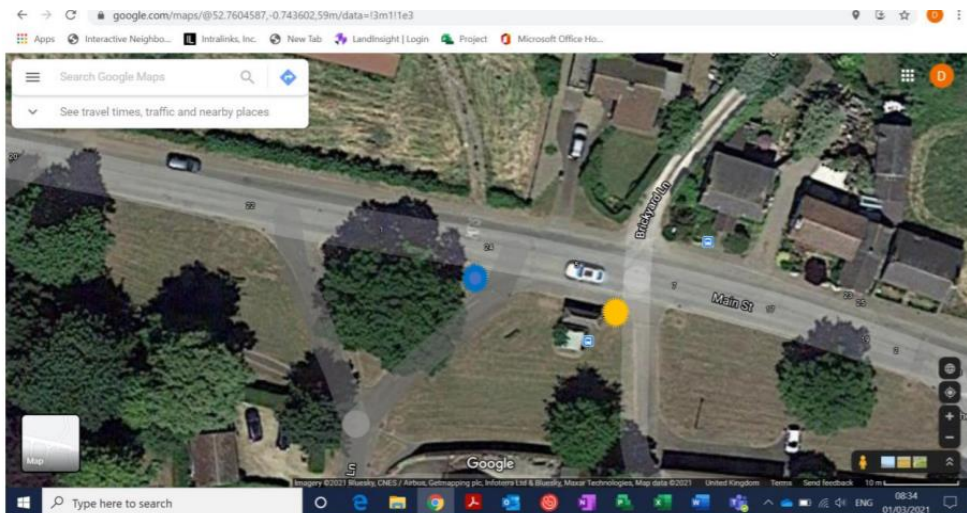
The meeting noted Cllr Gresham's interest in property opposite 219/1

218 Matters arising from previous meetings.

/1 to report on discussions concerning the placement of the new VAS devices on Main Street Wymondham (Cllr Williams)

Cllr Williams reported in detail the steps that had been taken by Cllrs Williams, Hobson and Mear to reach their recommended choice of site - see 219/1. These had included extensive discussions with local parishioners affected by the positioning, with LCCH to confirm a correct compliance with statutory provisions, the MBC Conservation Officer for planning agreement and Co-eval to confirm the technical requirements of all VAS positions.

It was recommended that the best outcome for the VAS position of the east facing camera be as the blue dot shown below.



/2 to receive an update on flood related issues.

Cllr Gresham reported on a very productive recent site meeting with LCCH which had produced agreement to carry out several works at Washbrook which would help considerably with flood issues at this point e.g. to create a spillway with concrete surface from the highway into the brook to help flood water recede more quickly.

Also the same meeting has significantly increased the likelihood of remedying problems at the Edmondthorpe bridge e.g. clearing the two blocked side arches of the bridge.

219 Matters for Discussion

/1 to consider the placement of the new VAS devices on Main Street Wymondham (Cllr Williams)

It was proposed and seconded that the east facing VAS camera be positioned as recommended in 218/1 and the west facing VAS site remain unchanged as previously detailed - carried with one abstention.
